IX. A. Naming of Camino Ricardo Park – (discussion/action)

The SummerHill Homes development off Camino Ricardo is progressing well. The bridge that will connect the new homes to the Commons Park is being constructed this spring/summer. SummerHill Homes has agreed to build a passive/open space park as part of the overall project. The new park is already designed and had previously been before the Park and Recreation Commission. One remaining task of the Park and Recreation Commission for this project is to name the new park. When looking for new names for streets, the Town typically references a 1990 document from the Moraga Historical Society (Attachment A). Attachment A is provided for your assistance to start the park naming conversation.

The naming process is up to the Commission, staff recommends the following approaches:

- Commission votes on a name and forwards to Town Council
- Propose a few names and ask the community to vote
- Consider staff suggestion – “Dos Arroyos Park.” Since the park is shaped by the convergence of the Corliss Tributary and Laguna Creek coming together, the proposed “two creeks” is suggested.
- Defer the task to the Moraga Historical Society or Town Council
