**V. PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Jean Moreau asked about portable microphone to allow the mobility disabled to speak at the meetings. Town Engineer Mercurio stated that they were looking into providing this.

**VI. CURRENT ISSUES**

- A.** Update on Current Outstanding Issues

Chair Reed had previously requested a number of bus stops to install parking restrictions along Moraga Road at AUHSD Corp Yard and another area across from Commons. The first was discussed with School District, which had no concerns about restricting parking in that area, and has since been red curbed. The one in front of the Commons is already red curbed – another parking restriction sign was added for clarification.

Vice Chair McInerney had asked from clarification on signage vs. red curbing. Town prefers signs because it is more enforceable and longer lasting – thus relating to less maintenance costs than curb painting.

**VII. ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS**

**A. 2010 ADAAC Members Recruitment**

Town opened up recruitment for the ADA Advisory Committee - information in the newsletter and posted appropriately. No applications for the ADAAC. Recruitment will remain open.

Vice Chair McInerney asked about other recruiting methods that may be more productive. Town Engineer Mercurio mentioned that we have in the past done active recruiting if we know of residents who may be responsive. Town Engineer Mercurio also mentioned that this is a moderately low time commitments. Vacancies were posted on the marquee with all of the opportunities for serving on Boards, Committees, and Commissions. Vice Chair McInerney said that he would bring it up at a number of service organizations.

Jean Moreau asked if the applications should be handed into Planning. Town Engineer Mercurio clarified that all applications should be turned in to the Town Clerk.

Town Engineer Mercurio stated that the next meeting is currently schedule for April 26.
