MTC and ABAG are in the process of developing the 2013 Update to the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). In response to SB 375, the regional agencies must develop an SCS – a feasible land use/transportation plan for the Bay Area – that will reduce greenhouse gas emissions from passenger vehicles. As the designated Congestion Management Agency for Contra Costa, CCTA staff is working with the regional transportation planning committees and local jurisdictions to inform them about the overall process. Judicial review of environment determination may be subject to a shorter time period for litigation, in certain cases 30 days following the date of final decision.
