THIS MEETING WILL BE CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDERS N-25-20 AND N-29-20, WHICH SUSPEND CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS OF THE BROWN ACT, AND PURSUANT TO THE ORDERS OF THE HEALTH OFFICER OF CONTRA COSTA COUNTY INCLUDING THE MOST RECENT ORDER DATED FEBRUARY 25, 2021, AND OTHER SUBSEQUENT ORDERS, WHICH PERMIT THE TOWN TO CONDUCT ESSENTIAL BUSINESS AND IS PERMITTED UNDER THE ORDERS AS AN ESSENTIAL GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTION

N-25-20 and N-29-20 from Governor Gavin Newsom and the Contra Costa County Health Officer Orders including the most recent dated February 25, 2021, the May 4, 2021 special meeting will not be physically open to the public. Town Councilmembers and essential Town staff will be teleconferencing into the meeting via Zoom.

The Mayor will call on people to speak by name provided or last 4 digits of phone number for dial-in attendees. (Please note that due to the remote nature of the meeting, the Town of Moraga cannot guarantee that the network or its site will not experience technical interruptions. To ensure that the Council receives your comments, we encourage you to submit your comments in writing in advance of the meeting.)

Comments received before 3:00 p.m. on the day of the meeting will be provided in their entirety to the Council prior to the meeting and will be a part of the record but will not be read verbally at the meeting.

Judging review of any Town administrative decision may be had only if petition is filed with the court not later than the 90th day following the date upon which the decision becomes final. Judicial review of environment determination may be subject to a shorter time period for litigation, in certain cases 30 days following the date of final decision. The Town of Moraga will provide special assistance for disabled citizens upon at least 72 hours advance notice to the Town Manager's office (888-7050).
