Consistent with Executive Orders Nos. N-25-20 and N-29-20 from Governor Gavin Newsom and the Contra Costa County Health Officer dated March 31, 2020 Shelter in Place Order, the April 21, 2020 special meeting will not be physically open to the public. Park and Recreation Commissioners and essential Town staff may be teleconferencing into the meeting via teleconference.
