<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Pathways and Paving</b> – while high priority areas have been completed, additional pavement repair is necessary on the internal pathways due to heavy cracking and deterioration.</li> <li>• <b>Poison Oak</b> Present – concerned regarding thick patch by path heading over the bridge</li> <li>• <b>Bench Plan</b> – update approved locations for memorial / donation benches. More seating desired in the skatepark</li> <li>• <b>Bocce Area</b> – additional bocce courts desired</li> <li>• <b>Banshell Stage</b> – in need of repair</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Pathways and Paving</b> – repair necessary on internal pathways due to heavy cracking and deterioration.</li> <li>• <b>Poison Oak</b> Present – concerned regarding thick patches around perimeter of the park</li> <li>• <b>Turf</b> – consider work to improve turf; if not replacement – resting and rehabilitation for sections in rotation</li> <li>• <b>Redwood Trees</b> – after 3 years of hand watering, significant improvement is noticed in the 4 Redwood Trees. Consider topping these 4 trees.</li> <li>• <b>Signage</b> – existing signage is deteriorating.
