MORAGA FOR MONARCHS

RECENT TOWN COUNCIL ACTIONS ON JANUARY 27, 2021

COUNCIL USE OF FORMAL TITLES

Town Council agreed to refer to each other and staff by formal titles to bring a level of professionalism to the meetings and show respect for the positions that Councilmembers and staff hold.

TOWN COUNCIL GOALS FOR 2021 - PART 1

Town Council discussed Mayor McCluer's proposed goals and the goals proposed by other Councilmembers. The 19 goals on the table were reduced to 13 which are scheduled to be brought to the February 10, 2021 Council meeting for further discussion and refinement.

STORM DRAIN REHABILITATION PROJECT DESIGN

Town Council voted unanimously to adopt a resolution awarding an engineering design agreement to WRECO (Walnut Creek) for the 2021 Storm Drain Rehabilitation project that focuses on the repair of three existing corrugated steel storm drainpipes: 1) a pipe culvert under Moraga Road; 2) a pipe under the upper parking lot at the Town-owned Hacienda de las Flores property; and 3) another pipe running through the Hacienda property. This storm drain rehabilitation project is not part of the separate Laguna Creek Restoration project. It is anticipated that design work will be completed at the end of 2021 and construction will start in late 2021 or early 2022.

PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING DAY AND TIME CHANGE

The Town Council voted unanimously to change the day and time of Planning Commission meetings. Effective March 2, 2021, the Planning Commission will meet the first and third Tuesdays of every month at 6:30 pm. The change in day and time will allow staff, the Planning Commission, and the public more time to review complex projects prior to meetings.

LOCAL SALES TAX OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE'S INDEPENDENT REPORT

The Town Council received a report from the Local Sales Tax Oversight Committee (LSTOC) on their review of the revenue and expenditures of the Measure K Local Sales Tax. This review affirmed the use of the funds consistent with goals and objectives of Measure K, specifically the funding of the Town's Pavement Management Program. The LSTOC's independent report was originally scheduled for presentation by Audit and Finance Committee Chair Larry Rosenberg on May 13, 2020 but due to an overcrowded agenda, followed by scheduling changes to the Town Council meetings brought on by the impacts of COVID-19, this report was delayed.
