The Canyon Road Bridge Replacement Project is progressing well. The contractor installed concrete footings for abutments and will begin installing forms for abutments next week. Following that, the contractor will begin installing falsework. Construction hours are Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. # CAMINO PABLO SECOND PUBLIC HEARING - TUESDAY, JUNE 15

On May 25, the Planning Commission recommended the Camino Pablo Annexation and Subdivision for 13 single-family homes at two-dwelling units per acre be denied as it was inconsistent with the adopted 2002 General Plan which would allow development of up to nine single-family homes. On June 15, the Planning Commission will consider the draft resolution for denial prior to sending the recommendation to Town Council. Of note, the Planning Commission felt that the project was generally well designed and had no major issues with the design of the project. ### NEW MORAGA LIBRARY HOURS BEGINNING JULY 1

Beginning Thursday, July 1, the Moraga Library will fund 40 hours a week, up from the previously funded 35 hours per week. The new hours for the Moraga Library will be Tuesday, 12 noon to 8:00 pm, Wednesday and Thursday 10:00 am to 6:00 pm and Friday and Saturday 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. They will be closed on Sunday and Monday.

## **RECENT TOWN COUNCIL ACTIONS ON JUNE 9, 2021**

#### WEDGEWOOD WEDDINGS LEASE AT THE HACIENDA DE LAS FLORES

Town Council discussed a potential lease agreement with Wedgewood Weddings to provide exclusive concessions and event management operations at the Hacienda. The potential agreement hosts numerous benefits to the Town including a significant reduction in the Town's net subsidy of the property while retaining community use of the park, grounds, Casita and La Sala buildings. The Town Council continued this item to the June 23 meeting so that negotiations can continue on three (3) outstanding lease terms. In addition to the community meeting that was held on June 7, the Town is working on mailing an informational piece to all neighbors within 500 feet of the property. #### FISCAL YEAR 2021/22 OPERATING AND CIP BUDGETS

Town Council reviewed and discussed the FY 2021/22 draft budget at the June 9 Town Council meeting which includes a \$10.3 million Operating Budget and \$9.9 million Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget, including a \$4.1 million FY 2021/22 appropriation and \$5.8 million in carryover funding. Thanks to one-time funding from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and excess fund balance in a pre-Prop 13 fund, the budget includes needed funding for storm drain repair projects and capital asset replacement. Consistent with the Council's 2021 priorities, the budget funds seven traffic safety projects. The draft operating budget projects a surplus of \$75,424 and a year-end General Fund Reserve level of \$4.98 million, or 50%, and will be presented for consideration and adoption at the June 23, 2021 Council meeting. #### 2020 PAVEMENT OVERLAY PROJECT COMPLETION

Town Council accepted the 2020 Pavement Overlay Project completed by Bay Cities Paving and Grading, Inc. The project rehabilitated eight streets: Ascot Drive, Ascot Court, Ascot Place, Calle La Mesa, Calle La Montana, Corte de Caballo, Idlewood Court, and Cedarwood Drive. The final construction cost was \$1,482,579 which was funded by Measure K, SB-1 Gas Tax and Garbage Vehicle Impact Fees.

#### ON-CALL CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES CONTRACTS

The Council authorized extending the Town's On-Call Construction Management/Inspection Contracts with CSG Consultants, Inc., Ghirardelli Associates and Harris & Associates for another year. The services are necessary to support Quality Assurance for the Town's maintenance and minor construction activities. The Town anticipates issuing a Request for Proposals (RFP) for a new contract during the upcoming 2021/22 Fiscal Year.

#### PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING PRIDE MONTH

The Town Council proclaimed June 2021 as Pride Month, recognizing the diverse Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Questioning+ (LGBTQ+) community of Moraga. The Town of Moraga is committed to supporting visibility, dignity and respect for all people and to providing LGBTQ+ youth a safe environment in which to grow and thrive.



## EBMUD MORAGA CREEK FLOOD AND EROSION CONTROL PROJECT

Condon-Johnson & Associates of Oakland, California was issued a Notice to Proceed for the Moraga Creek Flood and Erosion Control Project on June 8. A preconstruction meeting is scheduled between Condon-Johnson and EBMUD staff on June 17.
