TOWN COUNCIL MEETS NEW MYIC MEMBERS



The Moraga Youth Involvement Committee (MYIC) welcomed 12 new members for the 2023/24 term, increasing its membership to 22. The Committee serves as an advisory body to the Town Council on youth and teen issues and provides Moraga youth with the opportunity to engage in civic matters. The committee produces and assists with family-friendly events in Town, such as the Holiday Tree Lighting, and coordinates fundraisers, volunteer opportunities, and programs for young adults.

SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING SERVICES UPDATE

David Krueger, Executive Director, RecycleSmart, and Tony Mancini, General Manager, Republic Services, provided an overview on the improvements and changes that have been implemented recently to improve service to the residents of Moraga. LIVABLE MORAGA ROAD CONCEPTUAL DESIGN WORK

The Town Council approved to reestablish a professional services agreement for Livable Moraga Road with Alta Planning and Design. This contract is to resume and complete the last phase of the conceptual design work on the Livable Moraga Road project. The Town Council endorsed corridor configurations on June 22, 2016, and staff is now seeking approval to complete the remaining technical task of the concept level design drawings. GRADING PERMIT FOR EMERGENCY LANDSLIDE REPAIR

The Town Council approved a grading permit at 1392 and 1398 Rimer Drive to repair and prevent further erosion of approximately 100 feet of the Moraga Creek Channel located within the private rear yards. In January 2023, due to heavy rains resulting in increased creek flow, the creek bank failed and slid into Moraga Creek. The [Staff Report](#) is linked. In order to complete the work before the next rainy season, work on the site began under the grading emergency exemption in Moraga Municipal Code (MMC) §14.04.032.C. on August 25, 2023.

AMENDED TOWN COUNCIL PROTOCOLS

Council reviewed the proposed changes to the Town Council Protocols as presented by the Town Council Protocols Ad Hoc Committee. The Council unanimously agreed to accept all of the changes except Section 3.1 *Election of Council Officers*. The Council requested the Ad Hoc Committee to further refine the referenced section and return to the Council with modified proposals. View the [Staff Report](#).

“SAFE STREETS FOR ALL” GRANT PROJECT COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

The Town Council authorized a Project Funding Agreement with Contra Costa Transportation Authority (CCTA) for the US Department of Transportation (USDOT) Safe Routes for All (SS4A) grant funded Moraga Road and Canyon Road (St. Mary’s Road to Sanders Drive) Complete Streets project. This project has been listed in the Town’s Capital Improvement Plan since June 23, 2021 as a desired, but unfunded, project. In January 2023, USDOT awarded \$28.9 million SS4A grant funds to CCTA for five multimodal complete streets projects, including \$3.0 million in SS4A grant funding for the Town’s Moraga and Canyon Road Complete Streets project.

ADVANCING STIP FUNDS FOR EXCHANGED FUTURE MEASURE J FUNDS

The Town Council authorized a Funding Exchange Agreement No. 661 with Contra Costa Transportation Authority (CCTA) to receive \$536,000 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) grant funds for the St. Mary’s Road Multimodal Safety Improvements at Rheem Boulevard and Bollinger Canyon Road Intersection project (CIP Project No. 23-417). The project proposes to add a

traffic signal-controlled intersection at the St. Mary's Road and Rheem Boulevard intersection. It also proposes a dedicated left turn and possible traffic stop sign-controlled intersection at the St. Mary's Road and Bollinger Canyon Road intersection, with an analysis option of adding a traffic signal-controlled intersection later. CORLISS DRIVE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROJECT

The Corliss Drive Safe Routes to School Project has reached Phase 2 – Weighing Alternatives. The project is intended to improve pedestrian access along Corliss Drive between Warfield Drive and Arroyo Drive. DONATION OF FITNESS EQUIPMENT FOR RANCHO LAGUNA PARK

Town Council accepted the donation for fitness equipment in Rancho Laguna Park from Bobbie Preston. Ms. Preston is establishing an Outdoor Fitness Zone in memory of her late husband, Tom Preston. This area will be between the children's playground and the play train, across the grass from the Monarch Garden. There will be eight state-of-the-art machines, two of which will be ADA compliant, and will allow 22 people to exercise simultaneously on fun-to-use equipment. An app by the manufacturer allows individuals to track their progress. It is hoped the project can be fully funded and built by the end of October. MOFD ANNOUNCES GUTTER GUARDS NOW AVAILABLE

MOFD has received a shipment of "Gutterglove- Leafblaster Pro" gutter covering just in time for the worst part of our wildland fire season. These stainless steel guards are designed to minimize the accumulation of combustible material in your home's gutters and limit the surface spread of flame for at least 30 minutes. Having gutter coverings has the potential of protecting your home from damage due to flying embers. In the spirit of Dr. King's work, this year's theme is "Beloved Community." CONTRA COSTA COUNTY COVID UPDATE

Counties across the Bay Area are seeing an increase in the number of COVID cases. While the upward trends are worth monitoring, hospitalizations – our most reliable metric – are far below the heights seen during the Delta and Omicron surges. As of September 1, there were 84 new COVID-related admissions to hospitals in the County (eight more than the prior week) and the test positivity rate across the state of California was 14%, up almost 2% from the prior week. Contra Costa Health (CCH) continues to offer county residents free COVID test kits through the mail. Residents can request the kits online on [the COVID testing webpage](#). All 26 [county library branches offer free test kits](#) (limit two per household). At-home tests from a pharmacy are currently free or reimbursable for most people [in](#)

[California](#). Additionally, an updated COVID vaccine booster will become available later this month or early next month after the FDA and CDC approve it for use. County Health recommends that everyone stay up to date on their COVID vaccinations.
