DISPOSAL BANS

Some materials banned from landfill disposal can be recycled at these sites. Most other materials banned from disposal are accepted at local Household Hazardous Waste facilities.

Annual Clean-up Service. Most households are entitled to a once or twice a year clean-up pickup of extra waste at no extra charge. Call your garbage company to find out more about the types and amounts of materials accepted. In some areas the pickups are scheduled for certain dates and in other areas they are provided on an on-call basis. Donate reusable items instead of placing them out during clean-ups. Some communities offer reusable pickups before scheduled clean-up days.



Cover your load. It's the law. Local and state laws require garbage being transported in a vehicle to be covered in a manner to prevent dropping or spilling onto roadways. The California Highway Patrol may issue a \$1,000 fine for littering. Transfer stations and landfills may charge an extra fee for uncovered loads.



Stop illegal dumping. Please dispose of your waste properly.
