

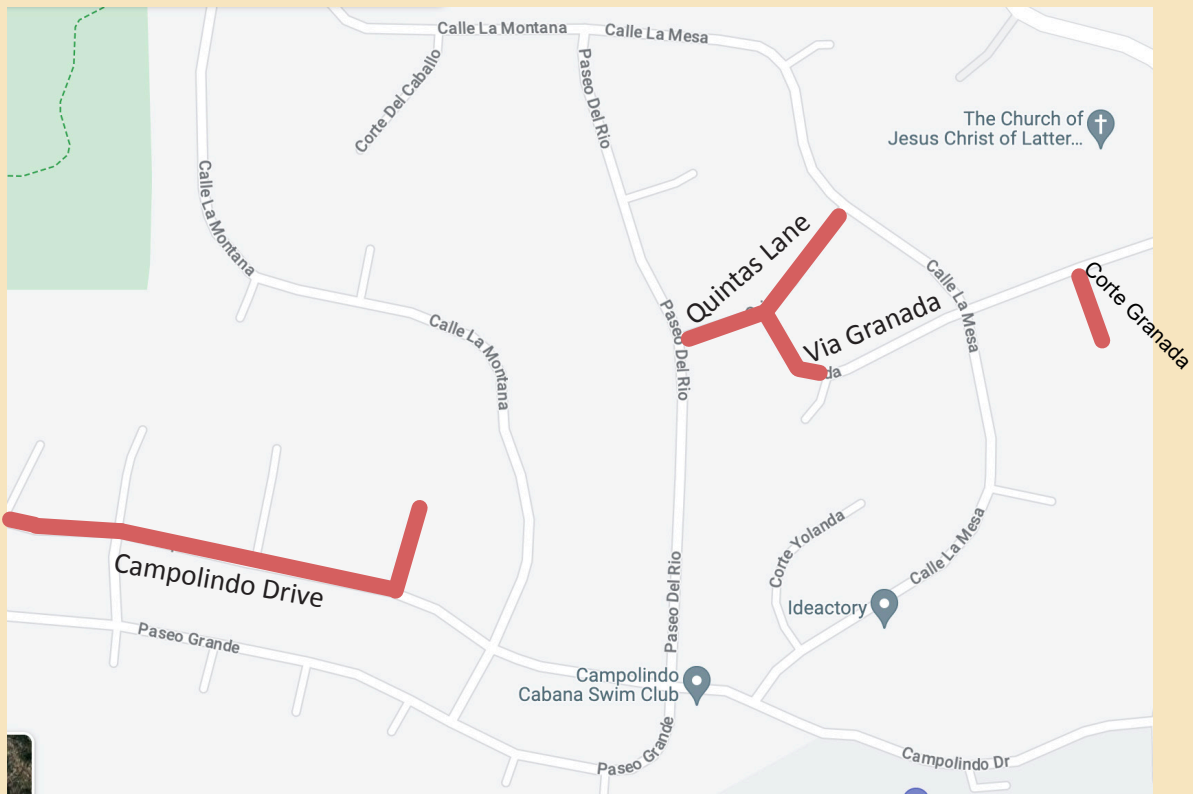
2022 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

De Silva Gates will be continuing Paving Operations in Area 3 (Shuey Drive) on Monday May 22nd, 2023, and also begin Grinding and Paving Operations in Area 1 (Campolindo Ct/Quintas/Corte Granada/Via Granada/Donald/Longfield).

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AREA 1 – Campolindo Ct/Quintas/Corte Granada/Via Granada/Donald/Longfield

- **Monday 5/22** – De Silva Gates (DSG) will begin grinding at Quintas with milling off the existing asphalt on ½ of the street with traffic cones down the middle. One lane of traffic will remain open on the opposite side. After grinding one side, traffic will be switched, and grinding will commence on the opposite side. Expect driving on existing dirt and base rock at 15 MPH.
 - Loose Gravel is a possibility and uneven driving surfaces should be expected. We recommend, if possible, to cover cars or park vehicles in your garages. If travel is a must, plan for up to 15-minute delays, but access to your homes will be maintained. Construction flaggers will be on site to ensure safe travel. Small earthen tapers will be added to ensure smooth driveway access.
- Campolindo Ct/Corte Granada: the entire street will be closed with a Flagger helping people in and out. The entire roadway surface will be ground out to subgrade. We recommend people to cover their car or park their vehicles in their garages, if possible. If travel is a must, plan for up to 15-minute delays, but access to your homes will be maintained. Construction flaggers will be on site to ensure safe travel. Small earthen tapers will be added to ensure smooth driveway access.
- Shuey Drive: DSG will finish the Final Paving overlay operation at Shuey Drive. DSG will begin paving ½ of Shuey Drive. One lane of traffic will remain open on the opposite side. After paving one side, traffic will be switched, and paving will commence on the opposite side. You should expect driving at 15 MPH. We recommend avoiding travel during work hours on this day. Street Parking will be available on adjacent streets and should be planned for.
- Sarah Lane: DSG will start the Final Paving overlay operation at Sarah Lane. The paving will be performed under One-Way Traffic Control with a flagger. We recommend avoiding travel during work hours on this day. Street Parking will be available on adjacent streets and should be planned for.
- We would like to avoid driving on fresh pavement and temperatures and will require 90 mins for the process and cooling down to a safe temperature. We can accommodate access in the case of emergencies.
- **Tuesday 5/23** – Campolindo Drive: DSG will begin performing base repairs operation on ½ of the street with traffic cones down the middle and one lane of traffic will remain open on the opposite side. Plan for up to 15-minute delays, but access to your homes will be maintained. Construction flaggers will be on site to ensure safe travel.
- Campolindo Ct/Via Granada/Quintas/Corte Granada: the entire streets will be closed with a Flagger helping people in and out. Base repairs will be performed under flagger control. If travel is a must, plan for up to 15-minute delays, but access to your homes will be maintained. Construction flaggers will be on site to ensure safe travel.
- Donald and Longfield: the entire streets will have one-way Traffic Control with a Flagger helping people in and out. Grinding will be performed under flagger control. If travel is a must, plan for up to 15-minute delays, but access to your homes will be maintained. Construction flaggers will be on site to ensure safe travel.

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- **Wednesday 5/24** – Campolindo Drive: DSG will begin base repair operations for the remainder of Campolindo Drive. This work will be performed under one-way traffic control. Plan for up to 15-minute delays, but access to your homes will be maintained. Construction flaggers will be on site to ensure safe travel.
- Donald and Longfield: the entire streets will have one-way Traffic Control with a Flagger helping people in and out. Base repairs will be performed under flagger control. If travel is a must, plan for up to 15-minute delays, but access to your homes will be maintained. Construction flaggers will be on site to ensure safe travel.
- **Thursday 5/25** – Donald and Longfield: DSG will start the Final Paving overlay operation at Donald and Longfield. The paving will be performed under One-Way Traffic Control with a flagger. We recommend avoiding travel during work hours on this day. Street Parking will be available on adjacent streets and should be planned for.
- We would like to avoid driving on fresh pavement and temperatures and will require 90 mins for the process and cooling down to a safe temperature. We can accommodate access in the case of emergencies.
- **Friday 5/26** – Campolindo Ct/Via Granada/Quintas/Corte Granada: DSG will start the Final Paving overlay operation. The paving will be performed under complete road closure with a flagger. We recommend avoiding travel during work hours on this day. Street Parking will be available on adjacent streets and should be planned for.
- We would like to avoid driving on fresh pavement and temperatures and will require 90 mins for the process and cooling down to a safe temperature. We can accommodate access in the case of emergencies.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation with this pavement rehabilitation project, and plan on completed each area within 1 week. Updates will be provided weekly.

Expect Delays on the aforementioned dates from 8 am to 5pm.

**Please note the schedule can vary slightly from what is provided depending on the contractor's production rate, means and methods, weather, underground conditions, and other factors. This is our best guess of the upcoming week's anticipated schedule.*
