Election of Town Councilmembers

On November 3, 2020, Moraga voters will elect three Councilmembers. The nomination period will begin on Monday, July 13, 2020 and end at 5:00 pm on Friday, August 7, 2020. However, if one of the incumbent officeholders does not file by the August 7 deadline, the nomination period for that vacancy will be extended (for any qualified person, other than the incumbent) until 5:00 pm on Wednesday, August 12, 2020.

Nomination Papers can be obtained from the Town Clerk’s office during the nomination period by appointment only. Candidates must be registered voters of Moraga at the time the Nomination Papers are issued.

Moraga-Orinda Fire Protection District

Fire season is almost here. Now is the time to start working on creating or enhancing your defensible space. You can help your home survive a wildfire by removing the combustible fuel next to your home and removing the receptive fuel beds that are present around your home. The fire district offers a free chipper service for residents doing fuel reduction work on their property. For more information about fire safety, our free chipper program and MOFD defensible space requirements, visit our website at www.mofd.org.

- Cut grass to no higher than 3 inches.
- Limb up trees to 6 feet off the ground.
- Cut bushes, shrubs and trees so they are separated and do not create a “fire fuel ladder.”
- Maintain roofs and gutters free of dead leaves and pine needles.
- Maintain 5 feet of vertical clearance between roof surfaces and portions of trees that overhang any building or structure.
