Campolondo Drive & Paseo Del Rio / Paseo Grande intersection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Upgrade the two (2) curb ramps on Campolondo Drive at Paseo Grande to ADA compliant ramps.</li> <li>Install yellow “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalks across Campolondo and Paseo Grande and install delineator curb extensions (bulb-outs) at all four quadrants.</li> </ul>
Campolondo Drive & Calle La Mesa	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provide an ADA compliant ramp on the southwest side of Campolondo Drive and upgrade the existing curb ramp on the southeast side of Campolondo to be ADA compliant, install yellow “High Visibility” Ladder style crosswalks across Campolondo and install delineator curb extensions (bulb-outs) at each leg of the intersection.</li> </ul>
Moraga Road and Campolondo Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Install green bicycle “Skip Striping” and white vehicular “Skip Striping” on northbound Moraga Road at the Campolondo intersection.</li> </ul>
Moraga Road at Woodford Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Install green bicycle “Skip Striping” on northbound Moraga Road at the Woodford Drive intersection and install delineator curb extensions (bulb-outs) on the southeast leg of the intersection.</li> </ul>
Moraga Road and Buckingham Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Install green bicycle “Skip Striping” on northbound Moraga Road at the Buckingham Drive intersection and install delineator curb extensions (bulb-outs) on both the northeast and southeast legs of the intersection.</li> </ul>
Moraga Road Corridor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Update aging signs at the median nose near Dolores Court and paint the nose of the curb yellow</li> </ul>
Moraga Road at Rheem Boulevard Intersection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The four (4) existing Crosswalks at this intersection will be upgraded to white “High Visibility” Ladder style crosswalks.</li> <li>New “Stop Bars” will be provided at each leg of the intersection.</li> <li>New “Shark-Teeth” yield markers will be added to the “Slip-ramp” from eastbound Rheem Boulevard to southbound Moraga Road.</li> <li>The pavement marking arrows and lane line delineations will be updated on Saint Mary’s to match the signage on the traffic signal.</li> </ul>
Moraga Road at Center Street	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The two (2) existing Crosswalks at this intersection will be upgraded to white “High Visibility” Ladder style crosswalks.</li> <li>New “Stop Bars” will be provided on Rheem Boulevard and at the northern leg of Center Street.</li> </ul>
Moraga Road at Rheem Shopping Center (Mid-Block Crossing)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>New “Shark-Teeth” yield markers will be added to both northbound and southbound Moraga Road along with “Yield Here to Pedestrian” signs.</li> </ul>
Moraga Road at Lucas Drive /Center Street intersection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The two (2) existing Crosswalks at this intersection will be upgraded to white “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalks.</li> <li>Double sided Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons will be installed on Moraga Road along with new “Shark-Teeth” yield markers.</li> <li>New advanced warning signs and “Yield Here to Pedestrian” signs will be placed along Moraga Road.</li> </ul>
Moraga Road at Ascot Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The two (2) existing crosswalks at this intersection will be upgraded to white “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalks and “Stop Bars” will be added at each leg of the intersection.</li> </ul>
Moraga Road at Donald Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The crosswalk on Moraga Road and the crosswalk on the eastern leg of Donald Drive will be upgraded to white “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalks.</li> <li>“Stop Bars” will be added to northbound and southbound Moraga Road and westbound Donald Drive.</li> </ul>
Moraga Road at Corliss Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The existing curb ramps at the southwest quadrant of this intersection will be upgraded to ADA compliant ramps.</li> <li>Approximately 75 linear feet of existing asphalt walkway on the east side of Moraga Road will be removed and replaced with ADA compliant concrete sidewalk.</li> <li>The existing crosswalk across Moraga Road will be upgraded to a white “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalk.</li> <li>The existing trail connection south of this intersection will be upgraded to provide a ADA compliant detectable warning strip. Pavement markings will be provided to separate pedestrian foot traffic and bicycle traffic through the intersection.</li> <li>Flashing beacons will be added in advance on both northbound and southbound Moraga Road.</li> <li>New “Shark-Teeth” yield markers will be added to both northbound and southbound Moraga Road along with “Yield Here to Pedestrian” signs.</li> </ul>
Moraga Road at West Commons Park (Mid-Block Crossing)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Advanced warning signs will be placed for both northbound and southbound traffic.</li> </ul>
Moraga Road at Saint Mary’s Road	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The two (2) existing crosswalks at this intersection will be upgraded to white “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalks and “Stop Bars” will be added in advance of the crosswalks.</li> <li>New pavement markings arrows will be added to Southbound Moraga Road and St Mary’s Road.</li> </ul>

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Moraga Road at Alta Mesa	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The existing crosswalk on the eastern leg of Alta Mesa will be upgraded to a white “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalk and the existing pavement markings will be refreshed.</li> <li>New “Shark-Teeth” yield markers will be added to both northbound and southbound Moraga Road along with “Yield Here to Pedestrian” signs.</li> <li>Flashing Beacons will be added to both northbound and southbound Moraga Road.</li> </ul>
Moraga Road / Canyon Road Corridor (Alta Mesa to Country Club Drive)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The existing pavement markings through this section of Moraga Road will be refreshed.</li> </ul>
Moraga Road / Canyon Road at Moraga Way	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Two (2) of the existing crosswalks at this intersection will be upgraded to white “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalks (southbound Moraga Road and Westbound Moraga Way.</li> <li>“Stop Bars” will be added in advance of the crosswalks.</li> <li>Install green bicycle “Skip Striping” and white vehicular “Skip Striping” on both northbound and southbound Moraga Road.</li> </ul>
Canyon Road at Country Club Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Realign the existing crosswalk on the northside of Moraga Road to make it ADA compliant by removing the “kink” and making it a direct route; this crosswalk will be a white “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalk.</li> <li>New “Shark-Teeth” yield markers will be added to both northbound and southbound Moraga Road along with “Yield Here to Pedestrian” signs.</li> <li>New white “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalks will be added to both sides of Country Club Drive along with Install green bicycle “Skip Striping”</li> </ul>
Canyon Road at Larch Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Install green bicycle “Skip Striping” and white vehicular “Skip Striping” on northbound Moraga Road at the Larch intersection.</li> </ul>
Moraga Way at Viader Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>New “Shark-Teeth” yield markers will be added to both eastbound and westbound Moraga Way along with “Yield Here to Pedestrian” signs.</li> </ul>
Moraga Way at School Street	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Two (2) of the existing crosswalks at this intersection will be upgraded to white “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalks (southbound School Street and westbound School Street).</li> <li>New “Stop Bars” will be provided at all legs of the intersection.</li> </ul>
Moraga Way at Ivy Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Install yellow “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalk on the southern leg of Ivy Drive</li> <li>A new “Stop Bar” will be provided at this leg along with refreshed pavement marking arrows.</li> </ul>
Moraga Way at Moraga Valley Lane	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Install white “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalk across Moraga Valley Lane.</li> <li>Pavement markings along Moraga Valley Lane will also be updated.</li> <li>Flashing beacons and advanced “Side Road Intersection” signs will also be added to both eastbound and westbound Moraga Way.</li> <li>This project will provide clearly designated pedestrian paths through the intersection and clearly mark the intersection limits for vehicular traffic. Additionally, motorists will be provided with an advanced warning of the presence of an intersection and the possibility of vehicles turning or entering traffic</li> </ul>
Moraga Way at Camino Ricardo/St Andrews Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Upgrade the crosswalks across Camino Ricardo and St Andrews Drive to white “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalk.</li> </ul>
Moraga Way at Hardie Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Install flashing beacons and advanced “Side Road Intersection” signs.</li> </ul>
Country Club Drive at Viader Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A new “Stop Bar” will be provided at the northern leg of School Street, “Stop” will be painted on the pavement prior to the crosswalk, and the yellow lane line will be refreshed at the intersection.</li> </ul>
Country Club Drive at School Street	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>New white “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalks will be installed across Viader Drive and the eastern leg of Country Club Drive.</li> <li>“Stop” will also be painted on the pavement at Viader prior to the crosswalk.</li> <li>New “Shark-Teeth” yield markers and “Yield Here to Pedestrian” signs will be added to both eastbound and westbound Country Club Drive.</li> </ul>
St Mary’s Road at Moraga Library (Mid-Block Crossing)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Double sided Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons will be installed on St Mary’s Road along with new “Shark-Teeth” yield markers.</li> <li>New “Yield Here to Pedestrian” signs will be placed on St Mary’s Road.</li> </ul>
St Mary’s Road at Carter Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Double sided Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons will be installed on St Mary’s Road along with new “Shark-Teeth” yield markers.</li> <li>New “Yield Here to Pedestrian” signs will be placed on St Mary’s Road.</li> <li>New delineator curb extensions (bulb-outs) will be installed at the southeast leg of the intersection.</li> </ul>

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St Mary’s Road at St Mary’s Parkway	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• New “Shark-Teeth” yield markers and “Yield Here to Pedestrian” signs will be added to both eastbound and westbound St Mary’s Road.</li></ul>
St Mary’s Road at Rheem Blvd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• New white “High Visibility” ladder style crosswalks will be installed across Rheem Boulevard at the Lafayette Moraga Regional Trail crossing.</li><li>• A flashing stop ahead sign, and an LED enhanced stop sign will be installed on Rheem Boulevard.</li><li>• New delineator curb extensions (bulb-outs) will be installed at the eastern leg of the intersection.</li><li>• Flashing beacons and advanced “Side Road Intersection” signs will be installed on both eastbound and westbound legs of St Mary’s Road.</li></ul>
Camino Pablo at Hodges Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• “Stop” will be painted on the pavement along with an additional “Stop Bar” and new LED enhanced stop signs will be installed at both eastbound and westbound Camino Pablo.</li></ul>
Camino Pablo at Sanders Ranch Road	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Median nose will be extended toward Camino Pablo on Sanders Ranch Road and a median “Cut through” will be installed in the median.</li><li>• A flashing stop ahead sign, and an LED enhanced stop sign will be installed on Sanders Ranch Road.</li><li>• Flashing beacons and advanced “Side Road Intersection” signs will be installed on both eastbound and westbound legs of Camino Pablo.</li></ul>
Augusta Drive at St Andrews Drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• New “Stop Bars” along with the word “Stop” will be painted on the pavement at each leg of this intersection.</li></ul>
